PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Principal, Mr. John Engelman, reported on the following:

- April attendance was good, 95.7%
- We only had 1 detention during the month of April. Discipline has been down this year.
- Our Bass Fishing Team won sectionals and is headed to State this weekend. The winning team consisted of Ryan Olsen, Delaney Platt and Coach Jerry Olsen.
- The Spring Play was held on Sunday, May 2nd.
- Abby Beck received the RVC Scholar Athlete of the Year award with a \$500 Scholarship.

BUILDING AND GROUNDS REPORT: Mr. Josh DeLong presented the following:

- Cafeteria work We will start this summer project on Monday, May 24. Work will begin with painting the walls and poles. New paint colors will be white, black and orange. A new epoxy floor will be put in, existing fans will be taken down and the entire room will be re-arranged. The kitchen area will also receive a makeup including new kitchen equipment.
