

ADDITIONAL GSW RETURN TO SCHOOL LOGISTICAL DETAILS

Facemasks are always required indoors.

- Students who ride busses will be symptom checked at the bus stop; all students will also be symptom checked before entering the school building.
- Parents should still self verify their son/daughter before leaving the house. Temperature and symptom check should be done at home each day.
- COVID Symptoms include:

Fever or chills

Cough

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Fatigue

Muscle or body aches

Headache

New loss of taste or smell

Sore throat

Congestion or runny nose

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea

Arrival 7:40 - 8:00 a.m.

Door 14 or Gym doors

- All junior and senior students will enter door 14.
- All sophomores, freshmen and ALL bus riders will enter the doors by the gym entrance.
- Students will stand outside the door with 6 feet distancing between the next person with their masks on. A staff member will check the temperature of each student and run a symptoms check.
- Students will go to their locker quickly and then directly to 1st hour class
- There will be no congregating in the hallways
- Any visitors will enter the vestibule near the office. Visitors must wear a mask and will not enter the main building.

DISMISSAL 12:00 P.M.

- At 11:57 am, the following classes will be dismissed Ms. Speizio, Mrs. Scaccia (Schaefer), Mrs. Ortega, Ms. DeHeer, Mr. Leigh
- All other classes will be dismissed by the bell at 12:00
- Students need to quickly dismiss from the school building

- Students who wish to grab a lunch or breakfast for the next day may proceed to the cafeteria to do so
- Bus riders who will eat lunch may quickly go to the cafeteria and eat before loading the bus.
- Bus riders who elect not to eat school lunch can go to the front of the building and space out while waiting for the busses to arrive
- Students need to keep face masks on while leaving the school and at all times while in the bus

BREAKFASTS/LUNCHES:

- A breakfast will be provided after school for the next day's breakfast.
- A grab n go lunch will be provided if desired.
- First hour teachers will take a lunch count
- Students who will be staying for lunch will report to the lunchroom and will sit in assigned seats that are socially distanced to eat their lunch between 12:00-12:20
- Bus riders will clean up and board the bus for a departure time 12:25 p.m.

HALLWAYS:

- Students should travel on the right side of the hallways
- Covid signage will be posted at entrances and around the school
- Water fountains will be covered with the exception of bottle refill stations; students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles to be refilled and use the fountains appropriately.
- All students are required to have a three ring binder where they keep their folders and notebooks and pencils and carry the binder with them all day which then limits the number of visits to their lockers.

BATHROOMS:

- No more than 1-2 students in the restroom at a time to allow for proper social distancing and handwashing.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned often throughout the day.
- Hand washing times will be available many times throughout the day, along with hand sanitizer available for use.

BUSSES:

- All students will be required to wear a mask.
- There will be assigned seats; siblings will be seated next to each other if applicable.
- An adult will be symptom screening each student before he/she enters the bus.
- There will be NO eating or drinking on the bus.

IN THE CLASSROOM

- When students enter the classroom, they are expected to get a wipe and wipe down their own desk as well as use sanitizer on their hands.
- Desks will be separated and socially distanced as much as possible
- Students will be required to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer throughout the day
- Students will not be sharing school supplies
- **Science:** Lab equipment will be disinfected between classes and disposable items will be used when possible.
- Some classes may elect to have class outside
- Students will have assigned seats
- IF teachers take students outside (weather permitting) Masks can be removed once students are outside but still socially distanced.

BAND

- There will NOT be full morning band until further notice

PE

- Physical Education will be outside (weather permitting)

IF YOUR STUDENT IS EXHIBITING ANY SYMPTOMS PRIOR TO SCHOOL, HAS BEEN EXPOSED BY A POSITIVE CASE OR SOMEONE IN THE FAMILY HAS

- Promptly notify the school
- Expect several screening questions and details to be asked
- Follow the advice of your health care provider
- Stay in contact with the school on learning options, return to school date, etc.

IF SYMPTOMS ARE EXHIBITED DURING THE DAY

- If a student is identified with a fever or potential COVID-19 symptoms, the student will be sent directly to the boardroom. Teacher will call Mrs. Huston to let her know so that she can take the temperature and symptom check. Parents will be notified.
